Delphi, Greece

The Oracle at Delphi was famous in its day, and everyone from rulers to common people to entire cities would come to the priestess with offers for her prophesies, which were usually cryptic (To avoid dependency and arrogance). The remains of the shrine/site still stand in Greece today.

Citadelle Laferrière, Haiti

The Citadelle Laferriere is an exceptional monument and historical site in the region of the Caribbean. It stands at the top of the mountain Bonnet a L'Eveque, on the northern coast of Haiti, symbolizing the Haitian slave revolution, liberty, and independence in 1804. Its construction was initiated by Henri Christophe former slave and one of the leaders of the Haitian slave rebellion who later became the king of Haiti.

The Parable of the Shrewd Manager

Luke 16 * "The master commended the dishonest manager because he had acted shrewdly. For the people of this world are more shrewd in dealing with their own kind than are the people of the light. It tell you, use worldly wealth to gain friends for yourselves, so that when it is gone, you will be welcomed into eternal dwellings.

¹³ "No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money."

¹⁴The Pharisees, who loved money, heard all this and were sneering at Jesus. ¹⁵He said to them, "You are the ones who justify yourselves in the eyes of others, but God knows your hearts. What people value highly is detestable in God's sight.

The Rich Man and Lazarus

- ¹⁹ "There was a rich man who was **dressed in purple and fine linen** and **lived in luxury every day**. ²⁰ At his gate was laid a beggar named Lazarus, covered with sores ²¹ and longing to eat what fell from the rich man's table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores.
- ²² "The time came when the beggar died and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. ²³ **In Hades**, where he was in torment, he looked up and saw Abraham far away, with Lazarus by his side. ²⁴ So he called to him, 'Father Abraham, have pity on me and send Laz

arus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, because I am in agony in this fire.'

- ²⁵ "But Abraham replied, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, while Lazarus received bad things, but now he is comforted here and you are in agony. ²⁶ And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been set in place, so that those who want to go from here to you cannot, nor can anyone cross over from there to us.'
- ²⁷ "He answered, 'Then I beg you, father, send Lazarus to my family, ²⁸ for I have five brothers. Let him warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.'
- ²⁹ "Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them listen to them.'
- ³⁰ "'No, father Abraham,' he said, 'but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent.'
- ³¹ "He said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead."

suspicion of unfaithfulness or fear of rivalry.

LEWDNESS: Lacking moral restraints.

The Worst Day in Earth's History Contains an Unhappy Warning



The worst day in the history of life on Earth, so far, happened almost exactly 66 million years ago, when an enormous asteroid slammed into the Yucatán Peninsula.

The asteroid—which arrived, <u>probably</u>, in June or July—immediately drilled a 20-mile hole into the planet's surface, vaporizing bedrock and spewing it halfway to the moon. The planet shuddered with magnitude-12 earthquakes, loosing tsunamis across the Gulf of Mexico. Some of the ejected debris condensed in orbit and plunged back to Earth as searing spheres of molten glass, which torched the land and turned forests into firestorms. Other debris remained high in space, where it blocked the sun's rays and began to chill the surface of the planet.
